"Judged By The Ancient of Days" Daniel 7: 9-14

<u>Verse 9 - 10</u>

The Throne of God

The Court was seated, judgment was made, the Books are opened -

Who is judged?

The antichrist and those who are deceived (those who believed the strong delusion) - 2 Thessalonians 2: 10-12

And those who worship the beast - Revelation 13: 15-17

<u>Verse 11 - 12</u>

The first to be judged - antichrist!!

The beast will be slain; the false prophet will be with him - Revelation 19: 19-21

Their final destination - THE LAKE OF FIRE - Revelation 19: 20

Satan's temporary abode - The Bottomless Pit for 1000 years Revelation 20: 1-2

What about those who were deceived, what happens to them?

Their temporary abode = Sheol, Hades, torment; the holding place for those who reject Jesus as their Savior

That is temporary, what happens next?

All the unsaved, through the ages, will appear at the Great White Throne Judgment - Revelation 20: 11-15

The final abode of the lost (those who reject Jesus Christ as their Savior) is the Lake of Fire

No believer, no overcomer will be at the Great White Throne Judgment!

They spend eternity, forever, with Jesus!!

Verse 13 - 14

Jesus Messiah receives His Kingdom

"One like the Son of Man coming with the clouds of heaven!" (vs 13)

- Jesus will return the same way He left - <u>Acts 1: 9-11</u>
- The Second Coming of Christ is visible Revelation 1: 7 "every eye will see Him" slow and steady....

Contrast this with the Rapture of the Church - FAST!!

1 Corinthians 15: 52 "In a moment, in a twinkling of an eye"

1 Thessalonians 4: 16-18 "For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of an archangel, and with the trumpet of God. And the dead in Christ will rise first. Then we who are alive and remain shall be caught up ("harpazo" = snatched away) together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And thus, we shall always be with the Lord. Therefore, comfort one another with these words."

Question:

Did Jesus ascend to heaven with a shout? NO!!

Was there a voice of an archangel? NO!!

Was there a trumpet of God? NO!!

In Acts 1:9 Jesus ascended slowly

In <u>Revelation 1: 7</u> Jesus will return slowly - "every eye will see Him"

At the Rapture,

Jesus receives His Church

At the Second Coming,

Jesus rescues Israel

CONCLUSION: JUDGED BY THE ANCIENT OF DAYS

The majority of earth will fall for antichrist's deception

Through an amazing, supernatural move of God, a multitude, which no one could number, will be saved - Revelation 7: 9-10 and 14

Our day is a prelude to what is coming: a world that calls wrong, right, and right, wrong - lsaiah 5: 20

A warning to America, to the western compromised Church - TURN AND LIVE! - Ezekiel 18: 23

The Ancient of Days sees all! Hebrews 4: 13

Judgment by the "Ancient of Days" is sure! A FACT!!

FACT: No believer will be judged for their sins; that took place at the cross
