
## "The Best Is Yet To Come" Daniel 12: 11-13



## Antichrist will come out of the fourth kingdom - ROME!




The Tribulation is a 7-year period of time - God will turn His attention to the Jewish nation

- 2) Submitting to God and resisting the devil James 4: 7-8
- 3) Taking captive every thought and making it obedient to God 2 Corinthians 10: 4-5

God hates pride; He will deal with pride -


Proverbs 13: 10

### **Verse 11 - 12**

### The Seventy-Five Day Interval - THE BEST IS YET TO COME!

- The demise of the antichrist is 1260 days from the mid-point of the Tribulation
- 2) For 1290 days, the abomination of desolation remains in the temple prior to removal
- 3) There will be 1335 days (45 days beyond the 1290 days) for those who survive the 75-day time frame to enter the Millennial Kingdom



5) The Marriage Feast of the Lamb is the event that begins the Messianic Kingdom

### **LESSON:**

- God has everything planned out perfectly
- God is a God of order; His timetable is perfect
- What will occur in the future is a done deal
- In times of uncertainty, you can rest knowing that God has everything under complete control

- You Daniel, go your way to the end of your life
- God will not forget His servants

C.T. Studd: "Only one life twill soon be past, only what's done for Christ will last."


Mark Twain (in his biography) records the end of someone who never knew the reason for life -

"A myriad of men are born; they labor and sweat and struggle for bread; they squabble and scold and fight; they scramble for little mean advantages over each other. Age creeps upon them and infirmities follow; shames and humiliations bring down their prides and their vanities. Those they love are taken from them, and the joy of life is turned to aching grief. The burden of pain, care, and misery grows heavier year by year. At length ambition is dead, pride is dead, vanity is dead; longing for release is in their place.
