"Letter to the Church of Ephesus" Revelation 2: 1-7



Christ addresses the seven Churches located in Turkey

How Christ views each Church:

1) Ephesus - lost their first love 2) Smyrna - the persecuted Church 3) Pergamos - the compromised Church 4) Thyatira - the corrupt Church 5) Sardis - the dead Church 6) Philadelphia - the faithful Church 7) Laodicea - the lukewarm Church

The order of the letter proceeds in a clockwise pattern representing the passage of time





Why only seven Churches? These seven Churches represent all the other Churches; these seven Churches are present today!

The invisible Church - all true believers that compose the body of Messiah

The visible Church - is composed of believers and non-believers since Pentecost

<u>Wheat and tares parable</u> -<u>Matthew 13: 24-30</u>

There are four things common to each Church:

 Each has a description of the <u>Glorified Jesus</u> - Jesus is in the middle of His Church

2) Each contains the words "I know" Jesus is aware of the condition of each Church 3) Each has the statement "he that overcomes"

"nikao" = one who gets the victory

- The Church is expected to overcome the challenges in this life (overcomers are true believers who get the victory)

> <u>1 John 5: 4</u> Proverbs 24: 10

4) Each has the statement "He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the Churches"

- Overcomers, heed the Word and do not buy into a non-biblical worldview!



The Destination

The destination is the messenger of each Church and its congregation

Ephesus had a disease, the disease of sensual unrighteousness which corrupted the people

The light of Ephesus died out!

America has the same disease - the light is dimming and may go out soon

What do you think Jesus is saying to America?

TURN AND LIVE!!

There is a true Church in America -Jesus is in the midst of His Church

Jesus will give His messengers and His Church the ability to <u>STAND</u> through persecution!

This is Jesus' promise to overcomers: carryout your mission - "... lo, I am with you always, even until the end of the age" - Matthew 28: 20

The reason you can overcome and have victory - GOD IS WITH YOU!!

Verse 2 - 3 and 6 The Commendation

1) "I know your works, your labor, your patience" - this is the get-going and get-doing Church

2) They did not put up with evil they called sin, *sin*, and wrong, *wrong*

3) They called out false teachers and false apostles - they called them liars!!

4) They persevered - they did not become weary

5) They hated the deeds of the Nicolaitans - who ruled over the people, created a distinction between clergy and laity, a power and control trip

What has God put in place to protect His sheep? *Pastors, shepherds, elders* Acts 20: 29-31



Verse 4

<u>Condemnation</u>: you have left your first love

Busy Church - Busy life = a set up for drifting

A drift preventer - time with the *Master*

In one generation, the believers had become lax and cold and drifted from God

This is called the *"second-generation syndrome"* - how is this prevented?

- 1) Pass on real faith allow others to see that you are all in
- 2) Live out your faith without hypocrisy no mask wearing!!
- 3) Be honest and be real when you make a mistake, own it!!
- 4) Don't be a "know-it-all" people retract from "know-it-all's", especially your children

5) Teach and model your faith - don't manipulate or coerce, but nurture and nudge in the right direction

6) Don't compromise under pressure don't become obnoxious, angry, or degrading; simply stand on Biblical principles with a gentle spirit

7) Be a God pleaser, not a man pleaser easier said than done!



Exhortation: Remember your first love and repent

<u>Repent</u> = "metanoeo" = a true change of heart and mind toward God

If we do not repent, our lampstand (our influence) will be removed - how sad!

How do we guard against losing our first love?

Let go and let God lead your life
Introspection - examine your life

How do we guard against losing our first love? (cont.)

3) When you catch yourself drifting, put your oars in the water and row!

4) Stay in fellowship - don't drift and become isolated

<u>Stay close to Jesus</u>; whenever there is a distance between Jesus and me, it is <u>not</u> that He moved - it was <u>me</u> that moved!



The Promise to overcomers

This promise is made to individual believers

If a Church goes astray, it is the believer who must overcome - the individual is responsible!

If a person finds themselves in a compromised *"progressive"* Church, run for your life!!

Overcomers will eat of the *Tree of Life*

The *Tree of Life* gives both the fullness of life and eternal life!

<u>CLOSING</u>: LETTER TO THE CHURCH OF EPHESUS

We must constantly be on guard against drifting and *losing our first love!*

We must avoid the *"second-generation syndrome"* by living genuine Christian lives

God's answer to the "secondgeneration syndrome" -Deuteronomy 6: 4-9

"HEAR O' ISRAEL" HEAR O' CHURCH TODAY (the Shema) HEAR!!

DO NOT LOSE YOUR FIRST LOVE!!
