

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#### **Destination and Meaning**

Destination - the messenger and congregation

<u>Smyrna</u> = means bitter; from myrrh, associated with death and embalming

**LESSON:** In the face of immense persecution, there are those who will stand



## *"You shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you"* <u>Acts 1: 8</u>

#### THE ABILITY TO STAND IS A GOD-GIVEN STRENGTH!!

#### Verse 8

#### **The Description of Jesus**

A <u>must know</u> for those facing imminent death or persecution -Jesus overcame death - <u>so will !!</u>

A <u>must know</u> - this is all temporary - we gain strength knowing this will end - Philippians <u>1: 20-21</u>

A <u>must know</u> - the key to any stressful situation - TURN YOUR <u>EYES UPON JESUS!</u> A <u>must know</u>- "Precious in the sight of the LORD is the death of His saints" <u>Psalm 116:15</u>

Precious = "timos" (Greek)
= held in honor, esteemed, dear,
 very costly - you are dearly
 loved!



#### Commendation

They were commended for their *works, tribulation, and poverty* <u>Poverty</u> = the idea of having nothing, of being destitute

These people were forced out of their jobs and had property confiscated. Why?

They would not bow to the state and say Caesar is Lord

True believers *must not* pledge allegiance to antichrist, or our government, over the True God!

*"We ought to obey God rather than men"* <u>Acts 5: 29b</u>

How can we stand this type of pressure? It must be God's miracle in us for the impossible!!

Zechariah 4: 6 tells us about Zerubbabel's impossible task to rebuild the destroyed temple *"Not by might nor by power, but by* 

MY SPIRIT, says the LORD of hosts"

<u>Jehovah Sabaoth</u> = the God of Armies is with you!! This is how you will stand !

#### Condemnation None

#### Verse 10 Exhortation

"Do not fear any of those things which you are about to suffer"

<u>A few things about suffering:</u>

 KNOW - This suffering was from the devil and not from God
 <u>suffer</u> = "pascho" = to experience something evil

James 1: 13

God never tests with evil! -

2) <u>KNOW</u> - We often don't know why we suffer - sometimes to purify us, or make us stronger, or to further His will. Many times, we simply JUST DON'T KNOW WHY!!

3) <u>KNOW</u> - Rest in knowing that God knows!

4) <u>KNOW</u> - If I stay close to Jesus, He is with me in the suffering, and through the suffering, His presence makes all the difference

#### 5) <u>KNOW</u> - Suffering has a time limit - *it will end*!

6) <u>KNOW</u> - Those who suffer for their faith will receive a martyrs crown (*reward*)

7) <u>KNOW</u> - An eternal perspective will help you -<u>2 Corinthians 4: 16-18</u>

GOD WILL GIVE YOU THE STRENGTH - STOP BEING AFRAID!



God's promise to the overcomer: They will not be hurt by the second death

The second death is the *Lake of Fire*, which is torment and eternal separation from God - <u>Revelation 20: 14-15</u>

The believer will die physically once -"...it is appointed for men to die once" Hebrews 9: 27

The unbeliever will die a second death -<u>Revelation 20: 5-6</u>

#### **<u>CLOSING</u>: THE CHURCH OF SMYRNA** THE SUFFERING CHURCH

God did not create us to suffer and die this was brought on by sin

We avoid suffering as best we can because it's *not a natural* part of the way we were created

Because Jesus overcame this world of sin and suffering, *the believer's* suffering is temporary!!

God sent His Son into the world to allow the believer to transition from the <u>abnormal</u> (*suffering and death*), to the <u>normal</u> (wholeness and completeness), with Him forever

No more suffering - *no more abnormal!* 

The only way to come out of the <u>abnormal</u> (sin and death), to the <u>normal</u> (eternal life), is to believe in God's Son and receive the *free gift of salvation!* John 1: 12

Believe and receive, or reject and regret - it seems so simple

The heart of God - 1 Timothy 2: 3-4

We must come to realize this life is not about me, *but about Him!* 

#### Come what may in this life:

#### MAY WE STRIVE TO BE OUR GREATEST FOR HIS GLORY

WE GLORIFY OUR LORD WHEN WE STOP BEING AFRAID!
