"Prelude to Chapter Four - Where is the Church?"

1 Thessalonians 5: 1-10

Facts regarding the missing entity - The Church

- 1) The Church had its start at Pentecost and will continue until the Rapture
- 2) The Fullness of the Gentiles there is a set number and a set time for the Church Romans 11: 25-26
- 3) The Church's commission is given by Jesus to every believer Matthew 28:19-20

God's plan for planet earth, to know Him, started with the nation of Israel

Israel (in disobedience over hundreds of years) rejected God and served the gods of other nations

The Result: God divorced the 10 Northern Tribes (Jeremiah 3: 8) in 722 BC, Assyrian Captivity


Judah, although seeing what God did, played the harlot; they went into Babylonian Captivity in 586 BC

Because of the Davidic Covenant, (2 Samuel 7: 12-16), God was not divorced from Judah, but was separated from her

Daniel was given a prophecy called the 70 weeks Prophecy - <u>Daniel 9: 24-27</u>

- 1) "Seventy weeks are determined for your people and your holy city"
- 2) This would total <u>490 years</u>; at <u>year 483</u>, Messiah would be cut off (killed, rejected) by the nation of Israel
- 3) At this point, time stopped for Israel, 7 years short of the 490 years


- 4) Israel was set apart for a time as God refocused His attention on a new entity, the Church
- 5) The gap between the years 483-490 is called *the Church* Age



- 6) With the Church removed at the Rapture, God will refocus on the nation of Israel and complete the last week of years the 7-year Tribulation period
- 7) To be consistent with Daniel's prophecy, the Church must be removed at the beginning of the "last week" the Church must be gone for the entire week

8) This is an important concept that one must grasp to understand the significance of a *Pre-Tribulation Rapture*

9) God's focus, in the Tribulation, is on Israel returning to Him; His focus is not on the Church

Why the Church is not present:

The Church will not experience the wrath of God - Romans 1: 18-19

What is the Day of the Lord?

A time when Christ takes over complete control of earth - Revelation 11:15

It begins with the Tribulation Period and extends through the Millennial Reign of Christ

In the "eternal state", everything is made new; all rebellion in the universe is put down forever

The Church will not experience the Day of the Lord (the wrath of God)

1 Thessalonians 5: 9-10

Revelation 3: 10

An important point to consider, God uses people to carry out His wrath - 2 Chronicles 36: 15-17; Psalm 106: 40-41; Ezra 5: 12



1 Thessalonians 4: 16-17 The Rapture Sequence

- 1) "For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven" He returns to earth's atmosphere, but does not touch the ground
- 2) ". . . with a shout" a military command as a Chief Commander to His subordinates
- 3) "...with the voice of an archangel" Michael repeats the order heard from Christ

- 4) ". . . . with the trumpet of God" soldiers will know what to do based on the sound of the trumpet
- 5) "...and the dead in Christ will rise first" out of the graves their bodies are transformed to their promised incorruptible, eternal bodies and will meet their spirit in the air that has come back with Christ

- "Then we who are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air" - We, who are still alive at this time, will meet the Lord in the clouds and be glorified NEW INCORRUPTIBLE BODY - YEAH!!
- 5) "And thus we shall always be with the Lord" we return to heaven with Jesus for the Marriage Ceremony (Church only, Bride only)
 Revelation 19: 7-8

The sequence of events for the Bride in Heaven:

- 1) All will be judged <u>Luke 21: 34-36</u>
- 2) The believer is judged for works done after salvation 2 Corinthians 5: 10
- 3) Believers are rewarded for quality of work, not quantity of work 1 Corinthians 3: 10-15

The sequence of events for the Bride in Heaven:

- 4) The Marriage Ceremony Revelation 19: 7-8
- 5) Marriage Supper of the Lamb on earth, with Old Testament and Tribulation believers Revelation 19: 9

There are three reasons for the Tribulation Period and none of them are for the Church (taken from Arnold Fruchtenbaum, "Footsteps of the Messiah")

- 1) To make an end of wickedness and the wicked one <u>Isaiah 13: 9</u>
- 2) Great worldwide revival Revelation 7: 9-10
- 3) Break the will of the holy people Daniel 12: 7

Recall what the Jewish people must do:

- 1) They must confess their national sin of rejecting Messiah
- 2) They must plead for Him to return
- The Tribulation Period is designed to break the will of the holy people
- God's focus is on Israel during the 70th week of Daniel the final 7 years of history

It is of utmost importance that you grasp what has been taught this week

Incredible changes are occurring in our world today, all a prelude to this incredible time called the Day of the Lord - a horrific, terrifying time; I simply cannot over state this!

What we have discussed is all true!
