Devil = "diabolos" = accuser, slanderer; one who cast himself between two

<u>Satan</u> = *"satanas"* = adversary, opposer of God and you

The devil's main tools are deception and discouragement

Discouragement comes with:

- Disappointments with people and life
- 2) When I am tired and worn out
- **3)** Fear of people
- 4) Loss of confidence (beaten down)

Steps to overcome discouragement:

- 1) Cry out to God spend time with Him - *meditate on His Word!*
- 2) Take a rest/reorganize your thinking
- 3) Think about God and not your problem/Take captive your thoughts renew your mind!
- 4) Return to your life *do not drop out!* The devil, the divider, wants you out of action!!

Group #1 - The Church and Old Testament saints

Group #2 - The Martyred Tribulation Saints

How do these Tribulation saints overcome Satan? (Revelation 12: 11)

- 1) The blood of the Lamb


The First Resurrection

For believers only!

Those who take part in the First Resurrection are *"blessed"*

<u>blessed</u> = "markarios" = fully satisfied It is <u>not</u> about your circumstances! <u>Markarios</u> is the one who is in the world, yet independent of the world!

Jesus blessed us when He became one of us - *human*! - <u>Philippians 2: 5-7</u>



Who are the overcomers?

Those who reign with Christ are those rewarded at the Bema Seat Judgment - 1 Corinthians 3: 13-15

Only overcomers reign Revelation 2:26

More clarification on this point: <u>2 Timothy 2: 11-13</u>

Order of the First Resurrection:

- 1) The first one resurrected is Jesus <u>1 Corinthians 15: 23</u>
- 2) The Raptured saints *Church-age* believers - <u>1 Thessalonians 4: 16</u>
- 3) The 2 witnesses Revelation 11: 11-12
- 4) The Old Testament saints Daniel 12: 2
- 5) The Tribulation Saints <u>Revelation 20: 4</u>

Order or Tagma (1 Cor. 15:23)

General – Christ's resurrection (1 Cor 15:23)

Officer – Rapture (1 Thess 4:13-18)

Soldiers – OT saints & Tribulation martyrs (Rev 20:4)

Captives – Unsaved of all ages (Rev 20:5)

The Second Resurrection is for the lost - <u>Revelation 20: 13</u>

Their resurrected bodies are eternal ad prepared for the Lake of Fire

<u>Verse 7 - 10</u>

Satan's last stand

Satan's sentence expires; he immediately reverts to his old ways deception!

Who does Satan deceive?

The nations, the entire world, the four corners of the earth!

Satan and his armies are allowed to surround the capital city, Jerusalem

God ends his rebellion post haste! Fire from God devoured them! The result of Satan's foolish endeavor (verse 10a)

> "The devil, who deceived them, was cast into the Lake of Fire"

In the final abode of all who rebel against God will be there (<u>verse 10b</u>)

"... tormented day and night forever and ever"

CLOSING THOUGHTS:

THE SAINTS REIGN -SATAN'S LAST STAND

Everything we go through here *is not* for nothing, it is not meaningless!!

We may not understand the crud, but God is using our life experiences to change us

The believer's life is all about change, transformation To really be a follower of Jesus you <u>must</u> have your mind, your thinking, transformed!

<u>Transformed</u> = "metamorphoo" = a change of condition; an internal change, a changed heart

Romans 12: 1-2 says it perfectly!

The glorified, fully transformed you, will reign with Christ!

Hold loosely to here, do not cling to this world - *it is passing!*

Clingers are not transformed and are not thinking with a renewed mind "For what will it profit a man if he gains the whole world, and loses his own soul?" <u>Mark 8: 36</u>
