New Beginnings May Be Uncomfortable Philemon 1: 8-25




Paul to Philemon:

Onesimus is changed, changed by Christ, I am asking you to forgive and restore

Many people desire to be forgiven, many have remorse, but are not really changed -

> They have not dealt with underlying issues and return to their old way over and over

This is an <u>ABUSIVE PATTERN!</u>



Forgiveness, by the hurt party, can be given to free them from the torturers

However, restoration is not automatic

Real change must be demonstrated over time for restoration to occur

The abuser and the abused must get help and not deny the problem!

THERE IS HOPE!

GOD IS A MASTER AT START OVERS!!


The grace of God knows no bounds God's grace is greater than all our sins!

Verse 8 - 11

Philemon may feel uncomfortable

We are made in the image of God with feelings and emotions (SOUL)

Tripartite nature



At the fall, our feelings and emotions were tainted and controlled by our old nature

Do not allow your feelings to rule you!



If facts and faith conflict with my feelings, I <u>do not</u> follow my feelings

The Holy Spirit will *"guide us into all truth"* – John 16: 13

The Holy Spirit will <u>guard</u> us from acting in our old nature

<u>YES, YOU CAN</u> change your script - you can respond differently

The Holy Spirit is in Philemon to <u>guide</u> him to forgive, *even if it is uncomfortable*! Your Christian life is all about change from flesh driven to Spirit driven!

Your flesh will fight against any uncomfortable changes

Your flesh wants its way – *it loves the status quo!*

The flesh dies hard; *it always wants to pop up and control*!



The only way to deal with MR./MRS. Flesh:

CRUCIFY KILL Galatians 5: 24

<u>Verse 12 - 14</u>

Onesimus may feel uncomfortable

Onesimus is returning to his master after stealing from him -UNCOMFORTABLE!

Principle: It is always difficult and uncomfortable to do the right thing

> Do not allow your feelings to rule you!

There are only two options: make progress or make excuses. Unknown

<u>Verse 15 - 16</u>

God can use the uncomfortable for His good

An uncomfortable Philemon, An uncomfortable Onesimus,

- Both acting contrary to their feelings
- Both were changed by Jesus
- Both were rescued from the sea of sin and are now brothers!

God brings *unity*! The world, the flesh and the devil *divide*!



God uses uncomfortable situations for *HIS glory*!

HE DOES THIS ALL THE TIME!

<u>Verse 17 - 22</u>

Paul ramps up the uncomfortable pressure

Philemon had to forgive – Jesus said so! Forgiveness is the Jesus way!

Forgiveness is good and healthy for you!


Remember: An unforgiving spirit is a bitter, tortured spirit

A healthy soul is a forgiving soul!

<u>Verse 23 - 25</u>

<u>Closing</u>: There are fellow warriors who are uncomfortable

In this culture fight, you are not the Lone Ranger



There are men and women who stand like a bull in a blizzard in a world that hates them

It will be uncomfortable here – JESUS SAID SO! John 15: 19

The Church in the west has an aversion, a disdain, for being uncomfortable

Laodiceans are never uncomfortable!

For the True Church:

- 1) It is uncomfortable to *live not by lies*
- 2) It is uncomfortable to not be silenced
- 3) It is uncomfortable to see, judge, act
- Nevertheless, God asks us to <u>STAND</u>! <u>Ephesians 6: 13</u> <u>1 Corinthians 16: 13-14</u>

IT IS A GREAT COMFORT TO KNOW THAT YOU ARE NOT ALONE!

For all who feel alone, distressed and uncomfortable with life:

Hear the Word of the LORD to you <u>1 Kings 19: 11-18</u>

You are not alone; *God and you are a majority*!

In a culture that wants you silenced SPEAK THE TRUTH!!

One word of truth can dispel a world of lies

Allow Paul's words to encourage you: Ephesians 6: 19-20

In our uncomfortable world, may you stand, *immovable with the truth!*

May you *fearlessly proclaim to all the mystery of the Gospel*!
