
# It Is Time For Jesus to Be Baptized – *But Why?*Matthew 3: 13-17

### Nothing is accidental with God!


Nothing is happenstance – all things are planned!

### **Verse 14 - 15**

### *It is time* – for John to baptize Messiah

# Omnipotent, omniscient, omnipresent, transcendent, immutable, everlasting, all mighty God!

### Why baptized?

- 1) Jesus was validating John as the forerunner
- 2) Jesus is identifying with those He would save in the future

### Why baptized?

- 3) Jesus' immersion was a symbol of His coming immersion into death
- 4) Jesus is demonstrating His taking the nature of man <a href="Philippians">Philippians 2: 6-7</a>

### Verse 16 - 17 It is time – resurrection to life

Jesus is victorious over death!

Shout it loud and clear!

"HE IS RISEN!"

"HE IS RISEN INDEED!!"

Jesus' resurrection is our future hope John 14: 19

John 11: 25-26


The moment you breathe your last you will be in the presence of God!

### There is a deeper meaning to Jesus' baptism and, I believe, our baptism

Jesus, as a man, was accepting His calling to be beaten, humiliated, and to die for our sins

Jesus' calling – John 6: 38:

"For I have come down from heaven, not to do My own will, but the will of Him who sent Me."

Jesus submitted to the will of Father as our example

### God's response:

"This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased"

We please and glorify God when we accept our calling and obey Him

Jesus burst forth in resurrection!
So will you one day - Jesus said so!
This you can count on!!

### What is Christian baptism?

Christian baptism is an outward sign of an inward change

#### At my baptism:

- 1) I am telling the world I am a "FOLLOWER" of Messiah
- 2) I am identifying with Messiah's death, burial, and resurrection
- 3) I am cut off from the old world of sin and death
- 4) I belong to a new world of life
- 5) I am making a conscious break from my old way of life

## "If one continues in his/her old ways, why be baptized?" Watchman Nee

The western Church (Laodiceans), shun baptism – "I don't need that", "It's no big deal"

For the rest of the world, the persecuted Church, it is a badge of honor; it displays COURAGE!

### Baptism is a big deal!

I am telling the world I belong to Jesus!


I am a *FOLLOWER*, not a *FAN* of Messiah!
