How To Live In An Evil World As Christians <u>Matthew 5: 1-12</u>



Being a disciple then and now will require "GRIT"

<u>GRIT</u> = bravery, backbone, guts, spunk





Disciples can expect the fullness of His grace

John 1: 16

1 the second For of His fullness we have all received, and grace upon grace. John 1:16 the-end-time.org

<u>Verse 1 - 2</u>

The Stage is set perfectly

The crowds are flocking to see Jesus, the excitement is palpable!

Jesus surprises the masses and withdraws to a solitary place with the 12 disciples

He begins to teach the 12 from the mountain top

The acoustics are perfect; the people can hear what Jesus is teaching



Jesus will teach us how to live in an evil world as Christians!

- Jesus' sermon is called *"The Beatitudes"* (Latin for happy)
- It is all about how to live here with a *"BE"* ATTITUDE!

All the Beatitudes are what we will "BE" when we dwell in Christ!!

<u>Verse 3 - 6</u>

"BE" Attitudes that are directed to God

<u>Blessed</u> = "markarios" = fully satisfied, joyful; the inner condition of the believer

THE POOR IN SPIRIT = helpless, one who needs lifting - <u>Psalm 3: 3</u>

> Those poor in spirit are helpless, lost, and realize their need for the Savior!

Promise:

"... theirs is the kingdom of heaven"

THOSE WHO MOURN = mourn over their sin; sad, grieved

Promise:

"... for they shall be comforted"

The picture is God holding you, embracing you

He is the "God of all comfort" <u>2 Corinthians 1: 3</u> THE MEEK = strong, but tender and humble; no self-agenda, is teachable; a controlled spirit

Promise:

"... they shall inherit the earth" Sounds like kingdom rule!

In meekness, Jesus is our example Matthew 11: 28-30

THOSE WHO HUNGER AND THIRST FOR RIGHTEOUSNESS

- Those who *continue* to hunger, *continue* to thirst

- Not streaky, not righteous in spurts, *but is continuous*

Promise:

"... they shall be filled" They will be satisfied!!

The first four "BE" Attitudes are directed to God

They will overflow into our lives, impacting our world!

<u>Verse 7 - 10</u>

"BE" Attitudes that are directed at the world

MERCIFUL = a forgiving spirit; does not hold people's feet to the fire; a spirit of empathy

Promise:

"... they shall obtain mercy" Those who give mercy will receive mercy Mercy gets involved – Romans 12: 15 **CAREFUL:** Mercy is not enabling Be discerning, mercy is <u>NOT</u> helping those who can help themselves!

PURE IN HEART

- Those who still blush at sin; those who live a clean life
- A life controlled by the Holy Spirit

Promise:

"... they shall see God"

PEACEMAKERS

- Brings peace into life's situations
- Has peace with God
- Can live with the peace of God

Promise:

"... they shall be called sons of God"



- Being a peacemaker is full time work
- Your flesh will not want to make peace, your flesh will want its way
- Flesh peace is self-centered peace, *"I get my way"* peace

PERSECUTED - Ridiculed for Christ - Ostracized for Christ - Martyred for Christ

Promise:

"...theirs is the kingdom of heaven"

Warning: Those who live out their faith will be persecuted - <u>2 Timothy 3: 12</u> <u>Philippians 1: 29</u>

Kingdom people cannot be friends with the world – *do you believe this?*



<u>Verse 11 -12</u>

Rejoice when persecuted – *WHUTT???*

The secret to suffering is not in the moment, no one wants to suffer

Suffering benefits are in what is produced when we suffer

<u>Romans 5: 3-5</u>

Not only that, but we rejoice in our sufferings, knowing that suffering produces endurance, and endurance produces character, and character produces hope.

romans 5:3-4

No believer is ever encouraged to pursue persecution, it will come naturally

If we cannot escape suffering, how are we to respond?

Revelation 12: 11

<u>A MUST KNOW:</u>

God will give you the strength at the time <u>Matthew 10: 16-20</u>

The world will never embrace the "BE" Attitudes – these are a God thing!

SURVIVAL PRINCIPLE:


- Stay close to the herd
