

Retaliation or Grace "But I say to you" Matthew 5: 38-48

"He (Father) has <u>delivered</u> us from the power of darkness and conveyed us into the kingdom of the Son of His love" Colossians 1: 13

Delivered = "ruomai" = to drag with force and violence; to draw out of danger





The closer you and your spouse get to Jesus, the closer you get to each other!

How are we to respond as kingdom of heaven Christians to unjust treatment?

<u>Verse 38 - 42</u>

Not to resist an evil person WHUTT?!?

It seems that Jesus is helping us to focus on the Law of Love Matthew 22: 37-39

Love starts with God and flows into you, then into your world

Not resisting an evil person is not easy!

It will require the Holy Spirit's power to do this!!

What Christ is <u>not</u> saying:

- To not protect yourself or your family
- 2) To let yourself be mugged; just grin and bear it!
- 3) To not resist an evil person, ever!

What Christ *is* teaching us:

- 1) Not to return in kind; pay back evil for evil
- 2) Not to bear a grudge, or hate those who mistreat you
- 3) Not to seek revenge, or look to retaliate
- 4) We are to do the supernatural LOVE AND FORGIVE!

tit for tat

tooth for a tooth


eye for an eye

= Law Talionis = Retaliation





JESUS GIVES 4 EXAMPLES REGARDING RETALIATION:

- Turn the other cheek do not resist a backhand slap on the face, meant to humiliate
- To sue you and take your tunic do not resist those who take material possessions, if it can maintain peace
 - Do not let a material possession be the cause of a disruption in a relationship

JESUS GIVES 4 EXAMPLES REGARDING RETALIATION (cont.):

- Go the extra mile when an oppressive government, *like Rome*, exploits the people for gain
- Help those in need be grace oriented; be generous, but discerning
 - We are not called to help those who are lazy, idle, or working the system - 2 Thessalonians 3: 10

Let's face it:

This teaching is *HARD*, impossible!!

This will not be you, but . . .

GOD IN YOU!!

Verse 43 - 48

Love Your Enemies WHUTT?!?

To <u>LOVE</u> them!

To <u>BLESS</u> them!

To <u>DO GOOD</u> to them!

To <u>PRAY</u> for them!

All are written as a "present imperative" = continue to <u>love</u>, <u>bless</u>, <u>do good</u>, <u>pray!</u>

- A *command* from our Lord to you!
- No exceptions!!
- If you are a believer, this is to you!!

To do this, you must be transformed Romans 12: 1-2

The goal is perfection - WHUTT?!?

"... be perfect as your Father in heaven is perfect" (verse 48)

Perfect = "teleios" = perfection of purpose; fit, mature, fully grown

Our perfection is found in Christ alone!


The Goal for you is direction,

It is *only in growing* that I can love my enemies


It is *only in growing* that I can pray for those who use me and persecute me

BELIEVERS ARE TO BE LIKE JESUS


When Jesus was crucified,
