







Masses of people think they are okay, but are not!!

The Three Tenses of "Salvation"

Past Tense:

Separation from the Penalty of Sin

You have been saved.

Justification

1 Connthians 6.11, Titus 3.5 Colossians 1.13, 14, Eph. 2.8, 9 Romans 5.1, 2, Colossians 2.13, 14

Present Tense:

Separation from the Power of Sin

You are being saved.

Sanctification

Philippians 1 6, 2 12,13, 2 Cer 5 17 2 Peter 3:17, 18, Romans 8:29 2 Connthians 3:18, 4:16, 17

Future Tense:

Separation from the Presence of Sin

You will be saved.

Glorification

Matthew 10:22; James 1:12 Hebrews 10:39; Revelation 2:10 Philippians 3:20, 21; 1 John 3:2

Verse 15 Beware of False Prophets

There is a real danger of being fooled by false teachers

Beware = to take heed, guard, watch, keep yourself



False prophets are hard to spot -

They tell you what you want to hear

They are savage wolves - Acts 20: 29

There are wolves amongst the sheep





Verse 16 - 20 How to spot the wolves

Key Point: "You will know them by their fruits."

Fruits = what a person produces, whether good or bad

Jeremiah dealt with false prophets Jeremiah 23: 25-27, 30-32

Jeremiah spoke the truth and the people seized him Jeremiah 26: 7-9

Later, Jeremiah was thrown into a dungeon Jeremiah 38: 6

We are living in a time of the apostasy of the Church - falling away from the TRUTH 2 Thessalonians 2: 1-3

The Church that dominates the end time is the Laodicean Church – Revelation 3: 14-22

Laodicean = the Church is ruled by the people

What do Laodiceans want?

2 Timothy 4: 3-5

Your protection in this era of massive deception:


Elders and YOU!

- 4) YOU be a Berean; search the Scriptures daily Acts 17: 11






A Pastor-Teacher's job is to rightly divide the Word 2 Timothy 2: 15



Verse 21 - 23 Are you a Professor or a Possesor?

Many profess Jesus, but do not possess Jesus!



Not everyone who calls Jesus, LORD, will enter the Kingdom of Heaven - SHOCKING!!

Many look good and sound good, but do not know the Son - they are tares!

Signs and wonders are not evidence of salvation –

Matthew 24: 24
2 Thessalonians 2: 9-10
Revelation 13: 13-14

Jesus' harsh words to false teachers and phony believers: "I NEVER KNEW YOU"

Many say, "I know Jesus", but the question is, Does Jesus know you? - John 10: 27

It seems that the life we practice has a great bearing on our salvation – if we are genuine!

Take note of these "CAUTION" verses:

1 Corinthians 6: 9-10

Galatians 5: 19-21

A Word of Encouragement:

"These things I have written to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, that you may know that you have eternal life."

1 John 5: 13

How does John say one knows they have eternal life?

- 1) Keeps God's commandments <u>1 John 2: 3</u>
- 2) Does not love the world system 1 John 2: 15-17
- 3) Love for the brethren 1 John 3: 14
- 4) Obeys what Jesus teaches John 14: 23-24

CLOSING THOUGHTS: FALSE PROPHETS AND FALSE WAYS

Many people are deceived and believe a message that appeals to their lifestyle

2 Timothy 2: 19 is clear - no room for error!

"Nevertheless, God's solid foundation stands firm, sealed with this inscription: "The Lord knows those who are his," and, "Everyone who confesses the name of the Lord must turn away from wickedness."" (2 Timothy 2:19, NIV)
