

"<u>Disciples</u>: When Criticized, Stay Focused on Your Mission" Matthew 9: 1-17

Criticism = the act of judging unfavorably; fault finding

Critical spirit = is never pleased; looks for faults; easily provoked

Constructive criticism = constructive feedback, supported by examples to help improve in some area; to build up, make stronger, improve, not tear down

To stand for something, one must be willing to accept CRITICISM!!





Verse 1 - 5 Jesus and the paralytic - *Criticism!*

Friends of the paralytic had faith in Jesus to heal - faith moves the heart of God!

Faith in Christ is very important - Hebrews 11: 6

Scribes (lawyers) criticize (fault find) within themselves - their thoughts betraying them!

Jesus knows men's thoughts - JESUS IS GOD!

Satan cannot read minds! Demons cannot read minds! Psychics cannot read minds!

God knows what you are thinking - kind of scary!!

Scripture tells us that only God can forgive sins - Isaiah 43: 25

Verse 5 - 7 That the world may know – JESUS IS GOD! - Criticism!

All cults, all world religions, do not believe that <u>JESUS IS GOD!</u>

"But that you may know that the Son of Man has power on earth to forgive sins" verse 6

Verse 8 The multitudes glorified God Criticism ignored!

LESSON:

Ignore the criticism, stay focused on the mission!

The multitudes glorified God, honored and praised God, <u>YET</u>, they think Jesus is a mere man!

Jesus did not look special; the European version of Jesus is false - <u>Isaiah 53: 2</u>

Jesus was swarthy - a dark-skinned, middle eastern Jew

Verse 9 Matthew is called - He will experience Believer's Criticism

Phases of Discipleship:

Come see

Come serve

Come suffer

Come be criticized

Come be different!

Matthew accepted his call and followed Jesus!

"He left all, rose up, and followed Him"

<u>Luke 5: 28</u>



Matthew did come see, come serve, come suffer!

Slain with a halberd in the city of Nadabah, Ethiopia in A.D. 60

Verse 10 - 13 Jesus eats with sinners -*Prejudice Criticism*

Jesus to the prejudiced:

"Those who are well have no need for a physician, but those who are sick"

Jesus hits them right between the peepers:

"Go learn what this means, 'I desire
mercy and not sacrifice"

These religious zealots were about sacrifices (the show) – their hearts were far from God!

Proverbs 15: 8 and 21: 3

<u>Isaiah 1: 12-13</u>

What sacrifice will God receive? Psalm 51: 17

Verse 14 - 17 John's disciples confront JesusReligious Criticism

Jesus looks and sounds like a man; John's disciples address Him *man to man*

- They do not know they are standing in front of their Creator!

Jesus helps John's disciples understand with an illustration – garments and wineskins

- 1) Don't put a new patch on an old garment it will tear and not hold
- 2) New wine into old wineskins wine will expand and break the wineskin and spill

Jesus is teaching John's disciples by illustration:

- Old is the Law with its rules and regulations
- New is the Spirit of grace

The New Covenant, instituted by Jesus' death and resurrection, is a **Grace Covenant** - **Ephesians 2: 8-9**

The Law kills, the Spirit gives life – 2 Corinthians 3: 5-6

The Old Covenant cannot be mixed with the New Covenant

The Protestant Reformers gave us five "Solas": Sola is Latin for "only"

- 1) Sola Scriptura = Scripture alone
- 2) Sola Fide = Faith alone
- 3) Sola Gratia = Grace alone
- 4) Sola Christo = Christ alone
- 5) Sola Deo Gloria = to the glory of God alone

Those few who embrace these beliefs, today, <u>will</u> face criticism!

CLOSING THOUGHTS:

Criticism: No one likes it, no one relishes it, but everyone experiences it


Yet, only a few (a remnant) experience criticism for Christ – most blend!


The compromised Church will not experience criticism, they walk lock step with the world!
