"The Fish and the Loaves/ YOU and the Impossible" Matthew 14: 15-21



Verse 15 The Disciples are too tired for the *Impossible*

What is ministry?

Ministry is service, implies sacrifice

Our family is a ministry, our work is a ministry, our entire life is a ministry

Ministry must be done out of the overflow of the Holy Spirit, not in our own strength!

We need the Holy Spirit's "POWER"

But you shall receive power when the Ho Spirit has come upon ou; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and Judea and Samaria, a to the end of the earth." Acts 1:8 NKJV

The disciples are unknowingly going to have to have a "Jesus test"

To test what they have learned?

Faith is always tested

Is our faith genuine, conditional, or unconditional?

The test will reveal the truth!

Verse 16 - 17 The Test: You feed them An impossible test?

Jesus to Phillip:


"Where shall we buy bread, that these may eat? But this He said to test him." John 6: 5

Phillip must have thought: This is IMPOSSIBLE!


The disciples are still in training, so are we!

They are still thinking in the natural, so do we!

Jesus is God of the IMPOSSIBLE!!



Nothing is too hard for God, absolutely nothing!!





Verse 18 - 21 Jesus enters the impossible

Jesus takes the loaves and fishes, "He blessed and broke and gave the loaves to the disciples"

LESSON: Disciples distribute the blessings of God to the people

What is Jesus demonstrating here?

Jesus is God, Jesus is the Creator, the deity of Christ is on display

Jesus created, out of nothing, the heavens and earth Genesis 1: 1

John clarifies who did the creation – John 1: 3-4

Paul adds to the wonderment of Jesus Colossians 1: 16-17

Jesus is God and holds the universe together,

AMAZING!!

Jesus, who created, holds all things together, including the atoms in your body!

Jesus, who created, feeds the 5000 with 5 loaves and 2 fishes, *a minor miracle for Him!*

Jesus calls Himself the "Bread of Life"

John 6:33-35

..."The bread of God is He who comes down from heaven and gives life to the world."

Then they said to Him, "Lord, give us this bread always."

And Jesus said to them, "I am the bread of life. He who comes to Me shall never hunger, and he who believes in Me shall never thirst."

LESSON:

Our job is to give and distribute the truth about Jesus

A few receive and believe

Most reject and don't believe

JESUS TO YOU AND ME:

I am the Bread of Life

I am all you need

I will give you more that you need

APPLICATION TO OUR LIVES:

GOD IS THE GOD OF THE IMPOSSIBLE - BELIEVE IT!!

We will need to remember this in the future

We will face hardships, and we may be called to suffer for the Master!

Reflect on what you have learned in this lesson

He is GOD, I tell you, the GOD OF THE IMPOSSIBLE!!

Jesus did seven signs in John that reveal His identity



Jesus Turns Water into Wine	John 2:1-11
Jesus Heals the Official's Son	John 4:43-54
Jesus Makes the Lame Walk	John 5:1-15
Jesus Walks on Water	John 6:16-24
Jesus Feeds the Multitudes	John 6:1-15
Jesus gives sight to the Blind	John 9:1-38
Jesus raises Lazarus from the Dead	John 11:1-44

Jesus has the power to change anything, or to get you through anything!

"When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; and when you pass through the rivers, they will not sweep over you. When you walk through the fire, you will not be burned; the flames will not set you ablaze. For I am the Lord your God, the Holy One of Israel, your Saucos." Isaiah 43:2-3a

hold on to the God of the Impossible!


Good news!
