
"The Transfiguration - A Preview of Coming Attractions" <u>Matthew 17: 1-13</u>

<u>Verse 1 - 2</u> The Transfiguration Event





Two Streams from the Old Testament Converge in Jesus of Nazareth

A Divine Messiah

A Human Messiah

Jesus has two distinct natures: 1) GOD 2) Human

Transfigured = "metamorphoo" = change of condition; changed from the inside out



What did the glorified Jesus look like?

Revelation 1:14-15 His head and hair were white like wool, as white as snow, and his eyes were like blazing fire. His feet were like bronze glowing in a furnace, and his voice was like the sound of rushing waters. Why the Transfiguration?

Jesus was revealing who He really is – <u>GOD</u>!!

Jesus would be transformed to His glorified state, pre-human form – <u>GOD</u>!!

<u>Verse 3</u> Why Moses and Elijah?

Luke 9: 30-31a -

"And behold, two men talked with Him, who were Moses and Elijah, who appeared in glory and spoke of His decease" (exodus)

<u>Luke 9: 31b</u>

".... which He was about to accomplish in Jerusalem" (His redemptive work)

<u>Redemption</u> = Pay the purchase price; the ransom was paid; *Christ's life for our life*



Verse 4

Peter believed in the Kingdom now

Peter was thinking this must be the Kingdom now - no death, no cross

Peter was familiar with the Feast of Tabernacles *(Booths)*, which is the picture of the Kingdom of God

<u>Verse 5 - 6</u>

A stunning "God Moment" interrupts Peter

A visual moment: A bright cloud

This is the visible manifestation of the presence of God; *the Shechinah Glory of God*

<u>A voice moment</u>: The stunning and terrifying voice of God

<u>The result</u>: "... they fell on their faces and were greatly afraid

The fearful voice at the giving of the Ten Commandments

What was the reaction before the enactment of the Ten Commandments?

STAMENT OF T

"And so terrifying was the sight that Moses said, "I am exceedingly afraid and trembling" (Hebrews, 12: 21) "Now all the people witnessed the thunderings, the lightning flashes, the sound of the trumpet, and the mountain smoking; and when the people saw it, they trembled and stood afar off. Then they said to Moses, "You speak with us, and we will hear; but let not God speak with us, lest we die.""

<u>Verse 7 - 8</u>

The Jesus touch – from terrified to comforted!

Jesus touched them:

Think touch Think cares Think comfort

Jesus to us constantly: *"Do not be afraid" - <u>Revelation 1:17</u>*

Think about Jesus' touch:

Think Shepherd who is with the sheep and loves the sheep

The only safe place for the people of God is by their Shepherd

THE ONLY SAFE PLACE FOR A SHEEP IS BY THE SIDE OF HIS SHEPHERD, BECAUSE THE DEVIL DOES NOT FEAR SHEEP; HE JUST FEARS THE SHEPHERD. A.W. TOZER

My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me. John 10:27

<u>Verse 9</u> Don't tell anyone, *yet*

There is a time and a place to speak, and a time and place to keep silent

A time to speak to dispel the lies

A time not to throw "pearls before the swine"

<u>Verse 10 - 13</u>

How does Elijah and John the Baptist play into this?

Elijah is coming before Messiah – <u>Malachi 4: 5-6</u> In Matthew, John the Baptist is a type of Elijah *"Elijah has already come" (speaking of John)*

CLOSING THOUGHTS:

Jesus was giving His inner circle information on who He is - GOD INCARNATE!

The Transfiguration is a "God moment"

Jesus is God – "It is a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the living God – <u>Hebrews 10: 31</u>

This speaks of those who sin willfully after receiving the knowledge of the truth - <u>Hebrews 10: 26</u>

What has happened to the fear of God?

The Hebrew word for <u>fear</u> is: "yare" = awesome respect or tremulous fear

Where is the awesome respect for God in America? Where is the fear of God?

There are a few, a remnant, that fear Him and respect Him

These few *(remnant)* have a promise that this world does *not* have

The promise of the presence of God, no matter what!

The promise that God has His loving, everlasting, eye on you

Behold, the eye of the LORD is on those who fear Him, on those who hope in His mercy.

To deliver their soul from death, and to keep them alive in famine.

Our soul waits for the LORD; He is our help and our shield.

For our heart shall rejoice in Him, because we have trusted in His Holy Name.

Let Your mercy, O LORD, be upon us, just as we hope in You. <u>Psalm 33: 18-22</u> There is a Kingdom coming, we saw a preview this week

THE KING IS COMING!!

The "eye of the LORD is on those who fear Him, on those who hope in His mercy"

His eye is on those who *watch and wait!*

In our world today, we see many previews of coming attractions

The real "Attraction" is knocking at the door
