


Outer Circle of Care

The 100-120 people that you know and care about. You hope that good things happen to them.

Circle of Influence

The 10-15 people who influence who you are, what you do, and how you do it.

Inner Circle of Intimacy

The 3-5 people in your life that you care the most about, who you spend the most time with, and who know the most about you

Where did we come from? (Origins)



a miracle can be defined as a periodic and temporary interference with the laws of nature so that God's presence, power, and/or purpose might be understood.

Verse 14 - 16

DOUBT – The Enemy of *FAITH*

Faith = "pistis" = being persuaded; confidence in divine truths; confidence in God

True Faith = believing in and trusting God through it all - Hebrews 11:1

"Now faith is being sure of what we hope for and certain of what we do not see"

Jesus and the inner circle descend to the plains and face a multitude in turmoil

The issue:

The disciples could not cure an epileptic (means moonstruck)

σεληνιάζομαι selēniazomai

Selene: Greek goddess of the moon

Latin: Luna

To be moonstruck was to be a *lunatic*, or loony.



With opposition comes <u>DOUBT</u>, doubting what was previously believed


The Percentage	of Christian Pastors
That Possess a	Biblical Worldview

All Christian pastors	37%
Senior/Lead Pastor	41%
Associate/Assistant Pastor	28%
Teaching Pastor	13%
Children's/Youth Pastor	12%
Executive Pastor	4%

This is termed "apostasy" - a falling away from the true Biblical faith

The result:

COMPROMISE!



Scripture warns us this will be so

Expect this!! 2 Timothy 3: 1-5

The vast majority of churches in America are MOONSTRUCK / LOONY!

No one can throw out Biblical teaching and not be *LOONY!*

<u>Verse 17 - 18</u>

Jesus sternly addresses the *FAITHLESS*

7 signs of John's Gospel

Water into wine - 2:1

Healing of the official's son – 4:46

Healing at the Pool of Bethesda – 5:1

Feeding of 5,000 - 6:1

Walking on Water – 6:14

Healing of a man born blind – 9:1

Raising Lazarus from the dead – 11:38

Seeing is not believing; believing is of the heart, not the senses!

Seeing is not believing. Seeing is seeing. Believing is being confident without seeing.

The disciples saw plenty and still struggled with believing (faith)

The disciples were given the power to do, but their lack of faith nullified their power

A believer's lack of faith does not please God


Hebrews 11:6 And without faith it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to him must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who earnestly seek

Verse 19 - 21

The FAITHLESS (unbelief) problem

Unbelief = not trusting or believing in God's power to do

Even little faith, *mustard seed faith*, can move mountains



"If you have faith as a mustard seed, you will say to this mountain, move from here to there, and it will move, nothing will be impossible for you."

Faith problem: Faith in the wrong object – <u>self</u>, our ability; in what <u>we</u> see as possible

Key Point: "nothing will be impossible" does not mean we have what we want, when we want

Nothing impossible is all about our faith surrendering to God's will

We will not, we must not, have all we want or ask for; we only have partial knowledge!

Be careful with being angry at God with our *partial* knowledge – <u>1 Corinthians 13: 12</u>



Psalm 37: 4 is often quoted to get what you want:

"Delight yourself also in the Lord, and He shall give you the desires of your heart"

Full context in surrounding verses helps us:

- **Verse 3 Trust in the LORD and do good**
- Verse 4 Delight yourself in the LORD
- **Verse 5** Commit your way to the LORD
 - Trust also in Him
- Verse 7 Rest in the LORD and wait patiently for Him
- **Verse 8** Cease from anger, do not fret, it only causes harm

IT'S ALL ABOUT GOD'S WILL, NOT MY WILL!

The cure for unbelief (not trusting in God's power to do) is <u>FAITH!!</u>

2 Corinthians 5: 7
Hebrews 10: 8

Jesus has an expectation of those who are His: To trust Him through all the impossibilities of life

In trusting, you will find the <u>FAITH-REST LIFE</u>

Our faith in God pleases God - Hebrews 11:6


We are living in the closing hours of time, as we know it on our planet, we must walk by faith!!

at war with God, ignoring God,


and despising God

One step at a time, I simply trust the One I am following


step by step
