
The Good Guy Quest for Eternal Life Matthew 19: 16: 26



The rich young ruler is on a quest for eternal life, the "I did it my way" quest

Verse 16

The quest involves an "<u>I</u>" focus, "What must <u>I</u> do?"

This man addresses Jesus as "Good Teacher"

He does not have a clue who is standing before him - GOD!!

John 1: 3

Acts 17: 25

Job 12: 10

The rich ruler joined the cry of humanity – "How can I live forever?"

Verse 17 - 19

Jesus' response: Good guys need to be perfect

Jesus' truth statement: "No one is good, but One, that is God"

To be good, one must keep all the commandments, all the time, perfectly!

James 2: 10

NO CAN DO!!

What is good?

Good, in God's eyes, is perfection; perfectly holy, like God Himself

PROBLEM: We are not perfect; we are all sinful - Romans 3: 23

"For all have sinned and fallen short of the glory of God"

PROBLEM: The wages of sin is death Romans 6: 23

GOOD NEWS: "The Gift" is eternal life for all who will believe and receive the gift - John 1: 12

Verse 20 The good guy thinks he is perfect

What do we call this?

Hubris, pride, arrogance, a man devoid of self-examination

For all who think they are perfect, I have this look for you




Verse 21 - 22

The good guy response to Jesus: "Oh no, not that!"

Jesus hit him in his good guy heart - "Go, sell what you have and give it to the poor . ."

Then Jesus gives him an invitation, an offer of salvation - "Come, follow Me"


This good guy sees through worldview, temporary eyes, and *not* spirit, eternal eyes!




Paul has something to say about worldview nearsightedness - 2 Corinthians 4: 18

The young man went away sorrowful, giving up the eternal for the temporary (stuff that burns)

Entropy is real, everything good will one day be dust!



ORDER TO DESCRIBE



Entropy applies to humans; you can't stop the clock!



Jesus tells us about entropy Matthew 6: 19-21

THINK ABOUT IT:

This good guy's only hope was rejected for stuff that burns!


Verse 23 Jesus warns about riches having you

Riches are not the problem, riches owning you is the problem

Jesus' illustration on the problem of riches

It is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a Matthew 19:24

than for a rich person to enter the kingdom of God.





The little door of the gate was called the eye of a needle. It was used for people to enter the city after the main door was closed at night.

Rich or poor, status or no status, we all come one way - as a child, humbly, through Christ!

The disciples see the impossibility, "Who then can be saved?"

Jesus' answer:


"With men this is impossible, but with God all things are possible"

SUMMATION OF SALVATION:

We are saved when we simply believe (trust in and accept as true for me) that Jesus is God's Son, the Savior from my sins

Salvation is absolutely free, and is apart from any condition or merit to earn it

Salvation is a God miracle - God acts to save by sending His Only Begotten Son to die for our sins. The human part is to believe and receive the gift!

Jesus' cry to all humanity: "Come, follow Me"

Remember the heart of God - 1 Timothy 2: 4

2 Peter 3: 9

1 Peter 3: 18

There is no neutral ground with Jesus, you are either for Him or against Him - Matthew 12: 30

You demonstrate you are for Him by following and obeying Him!

Cosmos – screams a Creator

Canon of Scripture – screams a Creator


Fulfilled prophecy – screams a Creator – only found in the Bible

There is one constant of men pursuing eternal life, none of them have succeeded


God determines the length of mankind's days
