Verse 1 - 3The marriage of the Son

The invitation goes out to every and all

The first offer is to Israel - Romans 1: 16

Christ's offer of betrothal has eternal consequences

The union, once accepted, is an eternal union, once for all

If rejected, also has eternal consequences - separation from God forever - hell

Verse 3 - 6

Servants are sent out; some are ignored, and some are killed

The second offer - God would send other servants, the disciples and the 70 in Luke 10: 1

Some ignored the invitation, some were persecuted and killed for bringing the invitation

Many today reject Jesus - He does not perform for them or do what they expect Him to do

GOD CARES!!

Think of words that describe how God is

 Immanent (close to us)

eg loving

Transcendent

(completely different

from us)

eg all-holy

Verse 7 Rejection results in judgment

God sees all and does not wink at the persecution of His bride, the Church

"... he was furious. He sent out his armies, destroyed those murderers, and burned up their city"

Your city will be destroyed – in 70 AD Rome came and Rome destroyed!

Jesus told them plainly why!

⁴³ For days will come upon you when your enemies will build an embankment around you, surround you and close you in on every side, ⁴⁴ and level you, and your children within you, to the ground; and they will not leave in you one stone upon another, because you did not know the time of your visitation."

Luke 19:43-44 (NKJV)

We should know that what Jesus says is coming!

"Have you not read?"

God holds us responsible for what is written in His Word!

Verse 8 - 10 God's invitation to all

The call is universal, every and all, are invited

Romans 10: 13 tells us plainly and unmistakably

"Whoever shall call upon the name of the Lord will be saved"

God desires that you be part of His family

BUT . . . one must receive the wedding invitation, believe and receive the gift of salvation

Verse 11 - 12 How did this guy get in here?

This guy was not clothed in the proper garments – the righteousness of Christ!

"But when the king came in to see the guests, he saw a man there who did not have on a wedding garment"

God's righteousness credited to the believer

Jesus

Christ

Justification


Other guests did not notice


He looked like, smelled like, acted like a guest, but was a phony!

No one is safe because they <u>think</u> they are safe!

One is only safe if "in Christ"!





Verse 13

The phony is rejected and thrown out

What happens next is tragic!

"... cast him into outer darkness; there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth"



Never ending jaw clenching, grating, never relief, constant discomfort, no hope of relief!

Verse 14 Who are the called and chosen?

Those who receive the call, and respond to the invitation, are the ones who are chosen

Chosen = "ekletos" = to select, choose for
 oneself; the idea of that which
 is choice

If you respond to the divine call, you can know that you know that you are chosen!

CLOSING:

It is truly bad news for all who reject God's invitation for salvation – JUDGMENT awaits!

It truly does not matter if one believes this or not

What is true is true!

God is not a liar!

God always tells the truth!!

One can ignore God and pretend that God does not exist

One can make God in their own image, pretend they are okay - SAFE!

One can believe they are good enough to enter the wedding – *they are not!*

It is truly all about believing and receiving the gift of salvation!!




Today, many people are running <u>from</u> God when they should be running <u>to</u> God!
