
Beware of the Traps – *They Catch Men!*<u>Matthew 22: 15-22</u>






Verse 15 - 16a

The trappers - the Pharisees and Herodians





Satan is a murderer and a liar, he hates mankind!

You belong to your father, the devil, and you want to carry out your father's desires. He was a murderer from the beginning, not holding to the truth, for there is no truth in him. When he lies, he speaks his native language, for he is a liar and the father of lies.

John 8:44



Beware of the world's philosophy traps

Colossians 2:8 (NIV)

[8] See to it that no one takes you captive through hollow and deceptive philosophy, which depends on human tradition and the basic principles of this world rather than on Christ.

Beware of the *"love"* trap – there are things that Jesus does <u>not</u> love!

Do not love the world or anything in the world. If anyone loves the world, love for the Father is not in them. For everything in the world—the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life—comes not from the Father but from the world. The world and its desires pass away, but whoever does the will of God lives forever.

1 John 2:15-17

Verse 16b - 17 The trappers set a trap

Beware of the flattery trap!

What is flattery

Flattery is when excessive and insincere praise is given to person or audience, especially to further one's own interests. Flattery, can be used to persuade people into believing your contention. People can be persuaded not by the Strength of the argument but they can be tricked by flattery into believing the contention.

Satan is an expert at trapping people!

His goal: Your demise!!









Verse 18 - 19 Jesus calls out the trappers

Jesus sees through the charade, "you hypocrites"

The masquerade trap - things are not as they seem!

II Corinthians 11:13-15

 13 For such are false apostles, deceitful workers, transforming themselves into the apostles of Christ. 14 And no marvel; for Satan himself is transformed into an angel of light. 15 Therefore it is no great thing if his ministers also be transformed as the ministers of righteousness; whose end shall be according to their works.

Verse 20 - 22 Jesus' tactics in the trap

Jesus' tactic: Ask a question

Greg Koukl, in his book "Tactics", gives us three tactics to use in a dispute for the truth - ASK

- 1) What do you mean by that? (Puts the emphasis back on the other person)
- 2) How did you come to that conclusion? (Makes the person think about their statement)
- 3) Have you ever considered? (Your chance to give them a Biblical view)

The Pharisees and Herodians are blown away by Jesus' response

"....they marveled, and left Him and went their way"

Love Him or hate Him, our world cannot help but admire Jesus!

The world citizen trap:

Go along to get along; don't make waves

In a sense, we are dual citizens:


Live, work, vote, and die here, but we do not belong here

We are temporary citizens here on visa; our real citizenship is not here, it is with God!

We look forward to our real eternal home!

Hebrews 11:13-16

These all died in faith, not having received the promises, but having seen them afar off were assured of them, embraced them and confessed that they were strangers and pilgrims on the earth. ¹⁴ For those who say such things declare plainly that they seek a homeland. ¹⁵ And truly if they had called to mind that country from which they had come out, they would have had opportunity to return. ¹⁶ But now they desire a better, that is, a heavenly country. Therefore God is not ashamed to be called their God, for He has prepared a city for them.



God has established governments and Christians are to be good citizens

BUT...

If the governments are against the precepts of God, we cannot obey

"We ought to obey God rather than man"

Acts 5: 29

Beware of the "ignore God" trap

Romans 13: 1 gives clear instructions for our dual citizenship: "Let every person be subject to the governing authorities"

1 Peter 2: 13 - "Be subject for the Lord's sake to every human institution"

<u>Subject</u> = "hupotasso" = to place in an orderly fashion under something, under a superior

Believers are to submit to government *unless* told by that government to disobey God

What did Jesus advocate for His followers?

Speak the truth in the culture!

We are to be ambassadors of Christ 2 Corinthians 5: 20

We are living in a changing America!

If the people are corrupt, the republic will be corrupt and not stand!

Beware of the government god trap:

Give you everything, own nothing and be happy (Communism 101)

What America is experiencing today is termed "soft totalitarianism"

People run from totalitarian regimes

Totalitarianism

- A government that takes total, centralized, state control over every aspect of public and private life
 - Police terror
 - Indoctrination
 - Propaganda and censorship
 - Religious or ethnic persecution



Christians today are living in a world that is transitioning to totalitarianism, antichrist system



How to avoid the Christian passivity trap:

- 1) Live filled with the Holy Spirit (toe in Christianity will not help you)
- 2) Speak out in the public domain with the truth! One word of truth counters a world of lies!
- 3) **VOTE!!** While we are free, do not sit on the sidelines
- 4) Stay connected, support one another!

Many Christians today want to take up arms - is this what Jesus advocated?

NO!!

Many want to sit back and do nothing - is this what Jesus advocated?

NO!!


Many want peace at all costs, peace at the cost of truth – is this what Jesus advocated?
