 Indignation that has risen gradually

 Settled condition of mind – revenge

 Lingering – seething emotion  Sudden outburst of passionate anger

 Blaze of temper – flares into violent words or deeds

Blowing off steam

## Verse 45 Darkness over the land



Darkness is associated with judgment Exodus 10: 21-23

God is placing all the judgment, that we deserved, on Jesus

INDEED, A DARK TIME!!

## <u>Verse 46</u> A cry of despair

It is here that Jesus experiences, for the first time, separation from His Father

A cry of despair:

"Eli, Eli, sabachthani!" "My God My God why he

"My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me!"

God cannot be in the presence of sin!

Jesus is hanging naked on the cross; every sin ever committed is being placed on Him

## Various responses to Jesus' suffering

## Some had compassion and wanted to help any way they could

The majority, calloused and uncaring, cry out – *"Let Him alone . . . "*

# PAID IN FULL

What is paid in full?

Jesus' death paid the price for our lives

Jesus sensed that God had withdrawn His presence from Him!

**Ever been there?** 

Job was there!!


### Job 23:8-10

- <sup>8</sup> "But if I go to the east, he is not there; if I go to the west, I do not find him.
- <sup>9</sup> When he is at work in the north, I do not see him; when he turns to the south, I catch no glimpse of him.
- <sup>10</sup> But he knows the way that I take; when he has tested me, I will come forth as gold.



God knows where I am, even when I do not sense Him or understand Him





#### What was accomplished at the Cross?

<u>Substitutionary Atonement - 2 Corinthians 5: 21</u>

<u>Atonement</u> = "*propitiation*" = an acceptable sacrifice pacifying the wrath of God

<u>Redemption</u> = Jesus paid the purchased price for us; purchased out of the slave market of sin

God's wrath is on all mankind because of sin

The only way for God's wrath to be removed is to believe in His Son's death in your place

#### Romans 5:8-11

### Reasons to Rejoice

Rom 5:8 (NKJ) But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that <u>while we were still</u> <u>sinners</u>, Christ died for us.

- 9 Much more then, <u>having now been justified</u> by His blood, we shall be saved from wrath through Him.
- 10 For if when we were enemies we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled, <u>we shall be</u> <u>saved</u> by His life.
- 11 And not only that, but <u>we also rejoice in God</u> through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received the reconciliation.

### This is an act of love; <u>however</u>, God's love is <u>not</u> greater than His other attributes


JEHOVAH = "LORD"

And sin separates us from God!




## One cannot cover sin with *"God is love"* and *"God, wink at my sin"*


Does God get angry and wrathful?



God's anger burns against the destructiveness of sin and rebellion against Him - <u>Romans 1: 18</u>

<u>Wrath/Anger</u> - we have all felt this! It is uncomfortable and unpleasant

We must learn to deal with our anger!

## The Anger of Men



For the Christian to live in anger/wrath, these are inconsistent with our new nature - <u>2 Corinthians 5:17</u>

Fleshly anger = a characteristic of the flesh is outbursts of wrath (thumos) - Galatians 5: 20

Simmering, not dealt with anger *(orge)* can crescendo into *thumus* anger

We must deal with our anger *(orge)* before our anger *(thumos)* deals with us - <u>James 1: 20</u>

<u>Righteous anger</u> = is directed at the consequences of sin - <u>Ephesians 4: 26</u>

If anger continues and marinates, it is not righteous, but selfish and bitter - <u>Hebrews 12:15</u>

### <u>Freedom from</u> <u>anger</u>: To realize freedom from anger, we need the Holy Spirit's power to help us!

Identify your triggers!

- Insults
- Stress and Worries
- Disappointment / Annoyance
- Fears, Resentment, Frustration
- Rejection / Hurt / Embarrassment
- Having possessions taken or broken
- Jealousy
- Being teased or talked about
- Low-Self Esteem
- Grief
- Home Life



## Anger is a problem

When it harms you When it leads to aggression When it harms People around you When it disrupts school or relationships When it is too frequent, intense and lasts long When it harms effects your overall quality of life When chronic, explosive anger spirals out of control

## **Dealing With Anger**

Cool off, stay calm.
Walk away
Count to 10
Take deep breaths
Use calming self-talk: "I can handle this. Chill. It's not as bad as it seems."
Imagine you are in a peaceful place.

### MY TWO CENTS: Take a time out and turn to God

- Forgiveness is an essential part of your recovery from anger
- Recognize you have been totally forgiven by God
- Forgive the debt and let it go
   FIDO = forget it and drive on
- Confess your anger and unforgiveness to the Lord
- Seek to reconcile if possible (not always possible)
- Once forgiveness is given, NO TAKES BACK, *don't bring it up again*!

# Q. What does it look like to forgive someone practically?

Forgiveness means you -

Don't seek revenge in any way.
 Cancel all debts.
 Don't criticize.
 Forgive unconditionally.
 Bless the person. (Blessings - wishing the best in life)
