Paul's Conversion₁

- Road to Damascus (Acts 9:1-19, over 134 miles "as the crow flies")
 - vv 1-2 seeking to arrest more Jews
 - vv 3-9 Blinded by light from Heaven
 - vv 10-19 Visited by Ananias, sight restored

Nerse 1 - 2 Bondservant An Apostle, separated to the Gospel

Bondservant = "dulos" = My will consumed with the will of my Master

Apostle = simply means "sent ones"

NAR = New Apostolic Reformation

- Claims that God is doing a new thing, raising up apostles and prophets with signs and wonders
- They claim to usher in the kingdom and make the world ready for the return of Christ
- This is contrary to Scripture; things will get worse and worse prior to Jesus' return

Matthew 24: 37; Luke 18: 8

Apostles of the Church describe what a person does, not who the person is

What is this bondservant, slave thing, all about?

- No one wants to be a slave; we think of the awfulness of slave traders
- Owning another human being, forcing them to serve is the worst of the worst abuses!

A bondservant, slave of Christ, is <u>voluntary</u>, an honored position of service for our Lord

I willingly submit, place myself under, the Lord He owns me, directs me, and is my Master!

THE DIFFERENCE:

My Master loves me, cares for me, blesses me and dies for me

I OWE MY MASTER EVERYTHING!!

Every human born into this world are slaves of Satan, their master

Jesus came to set the captive free - <u>Galatians 5: 1</u> (NIV) "It is for freedom that Christ set us free"

Jesus freed us by dying for us; He died in our place, paying our sin debt in full!

Those who are really free are those who bow to Jesus as their Lord and Savior

Those who do not want Jesus will continue to be slaves of their master, Satan!

BONDSERVANTS IN SCRIPTURE:

JESUS, Paul, Timothy, James, Peter, Jude, and believers - YOU!!

When I say that Jesus is my Lord, I declare my allegiance to Him alone!

As a bondservant, I <u>renounce</u> all the past masters of my life

As a bondservant, I give my life, my allegiance, totally to Christ, my Savior

As a bondservant, I will have no other gods controlling my life

Renounce is a big deal! You are proclaiming out loud to the demonic realm:

"I renounce all past strongholds in my life"


Strongholds:

A fortress, a prison; ways of thinking that are contrary to God

Ways of thinking that dominate your being, that <u>CONTROL YOU!</u>

We must deal with anger, lust, a critical spirit, addictions of every sort, and things we justify over and over!

<u>Strongholds</u>: Ways of thinking that are deeply embedded in our minds, controlling our lives



To overcome a stronghold, a person <u>must</u> dwell in Christ and take captive every thought!

"We demolish arguments and every pretension that sets itself up against the knowledge of God and take captive every thought to make it obedient to Christ."

2 Corinthians 10: 5 (NIV)

CLOSING THOUGHTS:

Who is your master?

We are all slaves to something or someone

Are you living as a slave to your past?

Some abuse or unfairness you have not let go of?

Are those feelings controlling you, destroying your peace, robbing you of purpose?

We must change from slave thinking to overcomer, freed-man thinking!

- **I cannot control** what has happened in the past (the pain is real)
- **| cannot control** what is happening in our world (constant daily stressors)
- Leannot control how others respond to what is happening in our world (the sky is falling)
- **Leannot control** someone else (nor do 1 want to) Impact, yes! Control, no!
- What I can control is me my responses, in the now!

Paul, speaking of the abuse of the Jewish leaders:

".... I consider everything a loss because of the surpassing worth of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord, for whose sake I have lost all things, I consider them garbage, that I may gain Christ."

(Philippians 3: 8) NIV

All the stuff of life is secondary to knowing Christ!

Jesus is my power source, my peace source, my hope source, my change source!

Is Jesus really your Master, or is some event or someone in your past your master?

Is Jesus really in control of your life?

What master controls you when your foundations are shaken?
