God is NOT able to do what?...

Never learns or surprised Isa 46:9-11
Never changes Mal. 3:6
No variation or turning James 1:17
Never fails a promise Num 23:19
Cannot lose His own John 10:27-30
Never abandons His own Rom. 8:38-39

### How God's 'ability' operates in our lives

- 1. Belief in God's ability <u>must not waiver</u> based on sight, feeling, experience...
- 2. God's ability does not obligate Him to satisfy the outcome we think is best...

God's ability given to us by the Holy Spirit dunamis (power)

His ability at work in & through us...

Without Me... nothing John 15:4-5
Through Christ... all things Phil. 4:13
Resist evil, temptation Heb. 2:17-18

Discernment Heb. 5:11-14

### Discipleship

Discernment – ability to understand truth (to distinguish truth from error) May be a 'gift' of the HS (...of spirits) Skill developed by training & practice Study of the Word exercised daily Prayer, application or 'constant use' **Evidence of spiritual maturity** True disciples grow relationship to God daily! Discern where He is at work... join Him Ministry: wait... obey... give... serve... God provides ability to willing believers

### Serving the body of Christ – the church

### God is able...

"To make all grace abound, always all sufficiency in all things, abundance for every good work."

(2 Cor. 9:8)

To work "mightily" in us as we preach, teach, disciple, labor, strive for Christ, the hope of glory (Col. 1:27-29)

There's no limit to what God is <u>able</u> do in & through His people as we pray in His will! "to Him who is <u>able</u> to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us,... (Eph. 3:20)
