

GLORIFICATION



FACT - Justification is not sanctification, but justification is designed to produce sanctification

FACT - God never saves a person to remain the same

Verse 1 - 2 Grace is not a license to sin

Some may think:

"I am saved by grace, I can still dabble in sin, I am covered, safe."

<u>WRONG</u>!

We love our idol, our sin

Our idol demands loyalty

IDOL = anything or anyone that captures our hearts, minds and affections more than God

Scripture calls these idols - <u>strongholds</u>

How do I deal with strongholds (idols)? Pull them down! <u>2 Corinthians 10: 3-5</u>

Our idol battle is a mind battle - he who controls the mind controls the person

Paul's response to "grace as a license to sin" rationale? <u>CERTAINLY NOT</u>!!

<u>Verse 3 - 5</u> Believers are baptized into Christ

Spirit baptism happens the moment a person believes in Jesus as their Savior

We were baptized into His death; the believer died when Christ died

The result of Spirit baptism:

We died and were resurrected with Christ – a new life! <u>CHANGED</u>!!

Because Jesus rose from the dead is a guarantee that you will rise from the dead

2 Corinthians 4: 14

<u>Verse 6 - 7</u>

GOOD NEWS – We are no longer slaves to sin

God views our old man ("in Adam") dead, done away with

We are justified, *declared righteous;* our old man is declared dead!

Our old man may be dead, but our old nature (our flesh) is alive and well, wanting to control us

Our old man is positionally dead - what am I to do with him?

<u>PUT HIM AWAY!</u> <u>Ephesians 4: 22</u> How do I put off the old man? By dwelling in Christ; making our home in Christ

Hear Jesus on how we must abide to change - John 15:5

Your flesh nature, which walks in concert with the old man, does not like your changed life!

As a matter of fact, your flesh idols will pitch a fit, and do anything to drag you back to the old life

Be prepared for an onslaught of pleas and rationalizations from our flesh idols

Live <u>FREE</u>, put off the old man and put on the new and be

<u>Verse 8 - 10</u> The changed you is alive in Christ!

FACT: I believed in Christ, and I was saved, I was given life - I am *"alive in Christ"*

I believe must lead to I behave differently -

A <u>CHANGED</u> YOU!

PLEASE UNDERSTAND: Some change fast - explosion change! Some change slow - almost imperceptible to the human eye -BUT NOT TO GOD!

No matter the pace, <u>CHANGE</u> will occur and must occur!

JESUS IS OUR EXAMPLE: We are to die to sin - we are to live to God!

This is what the sanctification process is all about - <u>CHANGE</u>!

<u>CLOSING THOUGHTS</u>:

How do you know you are truly saved?

You are <u>CHANGED</u>!

You are instantly taken from darkness to light, death to life, *"in Adam"* to *"in Christ" - <u>CHANGED</u>!*

Make sure you are genuine - How?

We are to examine ourselves – a personal examination

"Examine <u>yourselves</u> as to whether you are in the faith. Test <u>yourselves</u>. Do you not know <u>yourselves</u> that Jesus Christ is in you? Unless indeed you are disqualified." – <u>2 Corinthians 13: 5</u>

"Is Christ in you? It's not a matter of religion, but relationship. It's not a question of theology, but of intimacy. It's not knowing about Jesus intellectually but knowing Him personally." (Jon Courson)

HEAR JESUS:

"My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow me." (John 10: 27)

At some level
