Verse 7 - 8 Is the Law sin?

The Law is not the problem – we are! I cannot blame the Law for my desire to sin! The Law exposes what sin is For example: "You shall not covet" What is coveting? "Epithumeo" = upon the mind, a mind desire Desiring something contrary to God

Who was the first coveter, mind desirer? Adam and Eve coveted the forbidden fruit Temptation always starts with a thought - Decision time Will I embrace the thought? - Trapped Or Will I take captive the thought? - Be freed!

the nitty-gritty

the most important aspects or principles of something such as an experience or idea

Now that the planning is done, let's get into the nitty-gritty of executing the project.

10 COMMANDMENTS OF GOD

IX. YOU SHALL NOT BEAR FALSE WITNESS AGAINSTYOUR NEIGHBOR.


X. YOU SHALL NOT COVET.

The Law of God does two things:

> PROVIDES for and PROTECTS His people

<u>Verse 9 - 11</u> Again, the Law brings death

I had the death sentence stamped on me; the Law revealed that I am *GUILTY*!



The Law reveals our true condition - hopelessly lost, no hope, a goner!

Humanities only rescue is Jesus

Paul felt righteous, holy, safe and secure; a perfect law keeper *until !*

Paul met Jesus on the road to Damascus; he ran into real holiness!

He ran into God Almighty, the Lord Jesus Christ!

Paul was changed <u>from</u> a Jesus hater <u>to</u> a Jesus lover!

You, too, encountered pure holiness -

You, too, encountered the Master!

You, too, were steeped in your will, your way, your plans, then <u>JESUS</u> !

Jesus is a changer

JESUS IS A LIFE GIVER!

The Law reveals the pure nature of God

The Law of the Lord is perfect! Psalm 19:8-11

<u>CLOSING THOUGHTS</u>:

<u>Antinomian</u> = anti = against / nomas = Law Against the Law

Christians are released by grace from keeping the Law for righteousness – they are not against the Law!

Key word: <u>RIGHTEOUSNESS</u>

"For Christ is the end of the law for <u>righteousness</u> to everyone who believes." – <u>Romans 10: 4</u>

"For by works of the law no flesh shall be justified (declared righteous) – Galatians 2: 16b

No one will be declared <u>righteous</u> in His sight by observing the law, rather through the law we become conscious of sin." – <u>Romans 3: 20</u>

No one is <u>righteous</u> by keeping the Law; we simply cannot keep the Law perfectly Now, believers are under grace, not the Law The Law has <u>NO</u> bearing as far as salvation! Believers are under the law of Messiah

Jesus told us that obeying His commands reveals something:

 Obeying God demonstrates we truly love God John 14: 21; John 14: 23 Jesus replied: "'Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.' This is the first and greatest commandment. And the second is like it: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.' All the Law and the Prophets hang on these two commandments."

MATTHEW 22:37-40

2) Obeying God demonstrates that we know Him <u>1 John 2: 3-4; 1 John 3: 24</u>

When we obey God, we are telling all God deniers that we believe in Him

3) Obeying God demonstrates we are His <u>friend</u> Those who love God for real and obey God's commands are called <u>friends</u> of God Not every believer is called a <u>friend</u> of God Only two men in Scripture are called God's <u>friend</u>, Abraham and Moses Then there is **YOU!**

"You are My friends if you do whatever I command you." John 15: 14

You, too, can be a friend of God, how?

OBEY HIM!!

That is good news for weary travelers! Shalom friends - completeness, soundness, welfare,

PEACE GO WITH YOU!



Isaiah 26:3: "You will keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on You, because he trusts in You."

Shalom, Shalom repeated twice. In Semitic languages when you want to emphasize a word, you repeat it two times.

Thus, when your mind stays on God, you not only have peace, you have *really good* peace, peace peace, or *perfect peace*.
