Verse 1 - 3 Who did it their way? *Non-submitters*

For the "I did it my way" crowd, Proverbs 14: 12 is for you Saved = "soteria" = deliverance, preservation, safety

Saved from what?


Saved from the wrath of God on all who reject Messiah Saved to an amazing inheritance, heaven and eternity with God

All world religions and all cults have a zeal for God, "but NOT according to knowledge"

What knowledge?

Jesus is the Son of God - Deity - JESUS IS, IN FACT, GOD!

Hypostatic Union Fully God Fully Man



The Jews have a problem; people, today, have a problem

"... seeking to establish their own righteousness, have <u>NOT</u> submitted to the righteousness of God."

Every true believer will submit to Jesus' authority in their life

Every believer is no longer under Satan's rule, but submitted to Jesus' rule in their life


Verse 4 - 5 God's righteousness is through Jesus only


End = "telos" = the goal has been reached; the beginning of a new order of things

For those fixed on the Law, you must live by the Law perfectly! - Galatians 3: 10

Everyone who does not submit to Jesus' rule in their lives, salvation by grace through faith in Christ alone, will be judged by the Law

This is bad news! The verdict GUILTY!





We are now under the Law of Messiah

Matthew 22: 37-39

John 13: 31-35

I please Jesus when I submit to His authority in my life, when I obey Him

Verse 6 - 8 The Lord is near


TRUTH:

The Word is near

We have the Bible to give us direction

God is not far off, distant or uninterested

There is an attribute of God called "Immanent"



God is not far off, nor detached from His creation

He is close and CARES!

Verse 9 - 11 Believe and be saved

Salvation



Admit you're a sinner

Romans 3:10 "There is none righteous, no not one."

Romans 3:23 "For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God."



Believe Jesus is Lord

John 14:6-7 "Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me."



Call upon His name

Romans 10:13 "Whoever calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved."

"Confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus" is an action that occurs simultaneously with believing

One cannot confess unless they have first believed

I believe confession is agreeing with God and believing in His Son for salvation

Some believe in "Lordship Salvation" = Jesus becomes Lord over your life at salvation

When one is born again, they are a baby, on pablum, "in the milk" Christian



They know little about the Bible and what God expects of His people (this is normal)

Some are fixated in this baby state

They go through the religious motions with little growth



Growth occurs in the 2nd tense of salvation = <u>sanctification</u>

This is when one grows in the knowledge of Jesus and is conformed to the likeness of Christ

There is a process of change; not an instant change into a mature believer

I believe that one who is growing and maturing, becoming more like Jesus, is evidence of genuine salvation

2 Corinthians 5: 17

2 Corinthians 13: 5

Verse 12 - 13 There is no distinction – *All are savable!*

God is not a face-looker!

Jew, Gentile, male, female, slave, free – *all humans are savable!*

All are savable; Christ died for all the despicable; Christ died for me!

Be a grace giver; we are all in the same sin boat!

APPLICATION:

We use the inductive method of Bible study:

Exegesis - what the text actually says, *in context*

<u>Eisegesis</u> – making the text say what I want it to say, <u>not in context</u> Observation – What does it say?

• Interpretation – What does it mean?

- Ocorrelation What other Scripture supports this?
- Application How does that work for me?

- FACT: "For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God" Romans 3: 23
- FACT: "For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life" Romans 6: 23
- FACT: If you believe in Jesus, you, too, will be saved John 3: 16
- FACT: God has graced us and mercied us we must do the same to others!
- Luke 6: 36 "Be merciful, just as your Father also is merciful"
- <u>Matthew 5: 7</u> "Blessed are the merciful, for they will be shown mercy"

Marks of spiritual maturity:

- May our lives be marked by being a grace and mercy giver to one another
- Forgive and forget quickly
- Don't harbor resentment this will steal your joy
- Be quick to ask for forgiveness when you wrong someone
- Live free from offense and unforgiveness, and enjoy your life now and forever more with our Lord!
