

The F.A.C.E.S Acronym

- F – Fulfilled Prophecy:** Hundreds of detailed Old Testament predictions concerning nations, cities, and the specific coming of the Messiah (*such as His birth in Bethlehem or His crucifixion*) came true precisely as written centuries later.
- A – Archeological Discoveries:** Countless digs, ancient artifacts, and historical ruins continue to unearth specific names, locations, and events mentioned in Scripture, repeatedly confirming its historical accuracy rather than contradicting it.
- C – Consistency:** Despite being written over a span of roughly 1,500 years, by more than 40 different human authors, from vastly different walks of life (*kings, fishermen, scholars*), the 66 books of the Bible maintain a unified, seamless, theological message centered on God's redemption of humanity.
- E – Eyewitness Testimony:** The biblical writers - especially in the New Testament - frequently stressed that their accounts were based on direct, verifiable observation of historical events, including the physical resurrection of Jesus Christ.
- S – Science and Suitability:** The text displays an uncanny harmony with reality, and its practical, life-transforming power (*"suitability" or life change*) continues to validate its divine origin in the hearts of believers across every generation.
