

WILL OF GOD VERSE SAMPLES

Romans 12:2 (NIV) instructs, “Do not conform to the pattern of this world but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God’s **will** is—his good, pleasing, and perfect will.”

This suggests that aligning with God’s will often involves a transformation of our thinking and values.

1 Thessalonians 4:3

“It is God’s **will** that you should be **sanctified**: that you should **avoid** sexual immorality;”

1 Peter 2:15

“For it is **God’s will** that by doing good you should silence the ignorant talk of foolish people.”

John 6:40

“For my **Father’s will** is that everyone who looks to the Son and believes in him shall have eternal life, and I will raise them up at the last day.”

Hebrews 10:36

“You need to **persevere** so that when you have done the will of God, you will receive what he has promised.”

This verse encourages us to persevere and remain steadfast in doing the will of God. It reminds us that through our obedience and faithfulness, we will ultimately receive the promised rewards and blessings that come from walking in alignment with His will.

1 John 2:17

“The world and its desires pass away, but whoever does the will of God lives forever. Preceded by, **Do not love the world** or anything in the world.

1 Peter 3:17

“For it is better, if it is **God’s will**, to suffer for **doing good** than for doing evil.”

1 Timothy 2:3-4

“This is good, and pleases God our Savior, who wants all people **to be saved** and to come to a knowledge of the truth.”

These verses highlight God’s will for the salvation and knowledge of truth for all people. It underscores His desire for everyone to experience His love, grace, and forgiveness through a personal relationship with Jesus Christ.
